Room reservations can be made by phone, answering machine, or e-mail.

After making your reservation, you will receive confirmation from the reception personnel.

Cancellations and changes to your current booking will be notified directly to the guesthouse.

Rooms:

8 rooms with 2 beds

2 rooms for disabled persons (three beds in each room)

2 rooms with 4 beds

11 rooms with 6 beds

Price per bed and night:

Rooms with 4 and 6 beds – 80 SEK.

Rooms for disabled persons – 80 SEK.

Price per room and night:

Rooms for disabled persons – 280 SEK.

Rooms with 2 beds – 280 SEK.

Rooms with 4 and 6 beds – 280 SEK.

The rooms are available starting at **4:00 p.m.** on the day of arrival. Check-out time is usually **10:00 a.m.** at the latest.

A comforter and pillow, sheets and a large and a small towel are included in the price. A crib is available.

Guests have access to a dining area and communal kitchen. Every room has a space in a refrigerator and a space in a cupboard.

Only those attending the temple daily can reserve a room in the patron housing (accompanying children, however, are excepted).

Youth groups who are performing baptisms may stay at in the patron housing. Leaders are to reserve a separate room. According to instructions from the First Presidency, leaders are not to sleep in the same room as the youth

The following order of priority applies when reserving rooms in patron housing:

1. Temple visitors who are receiving their own endowment, children who are being sealed to their parents, visitors who are getting married, or couples previously married in a civil ceremony who are being sealed.
In order to have this priority, the room reservations must be made **no less than 4 weeks prior to the Monday** of the week of arrival.
2. Members who are visiting the temple when their stake, mission or district has an appointed temple week in accordance with the Temple Calendar for the year. Priority is for night to Tuesday – night to Friday. Members whose congregation has shift responsibilities for Saturday take precedence over accommodation at the guesthouse night to Saturday.
In order to have this priority, the room reservations must be made **no less than 4 weeks prior to the Monday** of the week of arrival. Room reservations are made by each unit's representative.
3. When all who have priority have been given a bed, the remaining beds are divided up on a first come, first served basis, according to reservation dates.

We often get requests from groups that want to use the patron housing for certain purposes, such as meetings, or using the kitchen for cooking. The Temple Department is quite clear in their directive that the patron housing is only intended for those guests who, in connection with attending the temple, use the patron housing as a peaceful and practical accommodation. We have been asked to decline other requests. We understand that access to patron housing would be practical for ward, district and stake activities, but we ask that you understand why we decline such requests.
